This mark indicates parks in which visitors may use portable barbecue grills, etc. (use of open fires is prohibited). However, this is limited to daytime hours and there are restrictions on the areas where barbecuing may be conducted. Please bring your own food and water and take all garbage home with you. Reserving spots in the park by leaving items on the ground is not permitted. (Reservation required at Shin-kiba Park and Tatsumi Seaside Park.)

Tools other than rakes may not be used for shellfish gathering. The shellfish gathering limit is 2 kilograms per person.

Parks which are more suitable for fishing. There may be restrictions such as on areas where fishing is permitted. Please enjoy fishing while being courteous to others.

Park where large scale construction work is scheduled in FY2019 (information as of Mar 2019). For information regarding temporary closures, please check the park's website. (There may also be construction at other parks. Please check directly with each park.)
