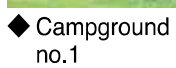
With camping grounds, a dog run, and a beach boardwalk, you'll feel like you're at a resort while still in Tokyo. Visitors to the park can also get an up close view of ships entering and leaving the Port of Tokyo as well as planes taking off and landing at Haneda Airport.

 - Parking: Area no. 1 - 85 spaces
 - Area no. 2 - 190 spaces (300 yen for the first hour, 100 yen/30 min thereafter, 500 yen(one-time fee) for campground users)
